Thanks to our Trust Land funding and Title 1 funds we have been able to develop a collection of readers by reading level for students to take home and read each week!



## ***To Succeed You Must Read!***



Mrs. Tribe is in charge of the Leveled Reader Program. The books will be taken to each kindergarten through 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classroom once each week so children may receive a new book. Books are to be taken home at the first of the week, read each night and returned by Friday.

If your student is in kindergarten you will want to read the book to them. As you read have your student point out letters or words they are learning. This is an important skill for a beginning reader.

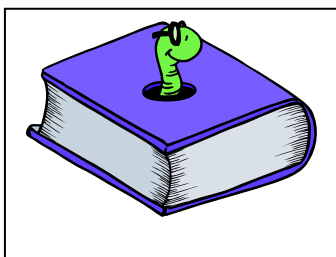
Older students may have reading records or forms to fill out about the books they are bringing home. They will be sent out by individual teachers.

Some students may read the book fluently the first few evenings they read to you. Those students may then turn to library books for additional reading.

Asking your student to retell the story or information in order is a comprehension skill that is easy to work on at home.

50 % of our leveled readers are fiction and 50% non-fiction.

We have placed each book in a storage baggy to protect the book and to help keep them looking like new! When they are done reading please place them in the baggy each time your student has finished reading and bring it back to WPA.
