- 1 package of wide-ruled lined filler paper
- 5 tab dividers
- 2 spiral notebooks (1 for math; 1 for science)
- Pencils and erasers
- Package glue sticks
- Post-it notes
- Colored pens (red, not blue or black)
- 2 pocket folders
- 3x5 index cards

# FIFTH GRADE

## **Suggested Individual Scholar Supply List:**

- One 2" sturdy 3-ring binder (will go from class to class with student)
- One 2" white, clear view 3-ring binder (will stay in the classroom as a cumulative file)
- 2 folders with pockets
- 1 package of college-ruled lined paper
- Extra pencils & erasers (a few will go in students' pencil pouches; the rest will stay in students' lockers)
- 1 skinny yellow highlighter
- 1 black Sharpie marker
- 2 colored pens (not black)
- 1 package of 8 divider tabs
- 2 black skinny dry erase markers
- 1 pencil POUCH that fits inside student's 3-ring binder (no loose pencil boxes, please)
- 1 pad of Post-it notes
- 1 spiral notebook (for literacy)
- 2 composition books (one for math, one for homeroom)

## **Optional\*:**

- Personal earbud headphones
- 1 flash drive (16 GB max, 2.0 USB)

\*Students will **not** need other supplies such as crayons, colored pencils, markers, scissors, tape, staplers, pencil sharpeners, rulers, and glue sticks. These items take up valuable space in pencil pouches and tend to become distractions. Each teacher has a supply of these items; students are welcome to donate to the general classroom supply.
