

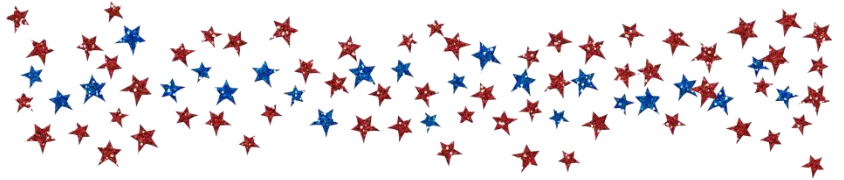

A NOTE FROM MRS. PILKINGTON:

Dear WPA Families,

Emergency Communications Procedures – Severe Weather Closure Days

Wasatch Peak Academy works hard to remain open, if at all possible, on all scheduled school days. Even when weather conditions are severe, every effort will be made to keep schools open in the belief that it is in the best interest of the students. Wasatch Peak Academy is concerned about the safety of all students, staff and patrons. We encourage everyone to use caution traveling safely to and from school.

On occasion, weather may be so extreme the school will close or implement a late start or early dismissal. The following information outlines the communication procedures that will be followed if such school closures or delays become necessary.

- **One Call Voicemail and Text Messaging**
Wasatch Peak will employ the text and voicemail messaging system to notify parents of a school closure, late start, or early release. It is the same system that we utilize for other notifications. If you are not receiving notifications from the school and would like to please contact the front office.
- **Keep School Phone Lines Accessible**
In the event of an emergency or significant weather phones will be used for emergencies; therefore, parents are asked not to call the school.

- **We Follow Local School District Closures**

If Davis School District is closed for the day due to weather it is safe to assume that Wasatch Peak will also be closed due to weather. (Please be aware that there are times when only some of the schools in the district will be closed. For example, if only Northern Davis School District schools are closed but Foxborough and Odyssey Elementary are open Wasatch Peak will be open as well.)

- **Closures for One Day Only**

All announcements are for one day only.

- **Normal Operation**

No announcement means normal operation.

- **Parents Need an Emergency Plan**

Parents are encouraged to establish an emergency plan for their children in the event that schools are closed, start late or are dismissed early. Parents should instruct their children where to go or what to do if a parent is not at home. (Please remember that in the event of an early release we will NOT be able to release your child to individuals not listed in aspire as emergency contacts. This means that if your child travels home with the neighbor across the street every day and they are not on your child's emergency contact list we will NOT be able to send them home with that neighbor in the event that there is an emergency. Please use Aspire or contact the front office to update these lists accordingly.)

- **Make-up Days**

The Utah State Board of Education requires a minimum of 180 instructional days of school. Days lost because of inclement weather will be made up first on the Washington and Lincoln Day Recess (Presidents' Day) and then during Spring Recess.

- **Late Start**

When the school has designated a school day as "Start Late," the expectation is that school will start at 10:00 A.M. You will be notified via text and/or phone message if the plan deviates from this.
