

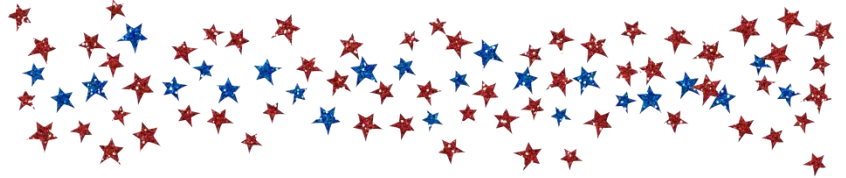

A NOTE FROM MS. PILKINGTON:

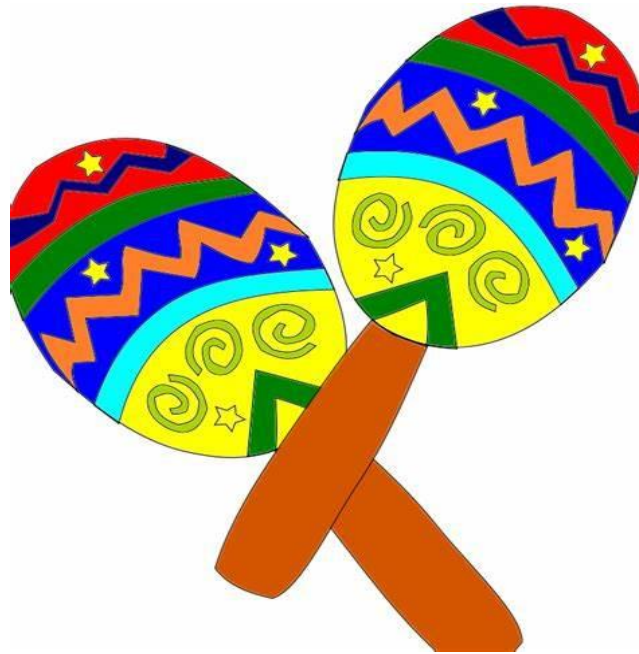
Greetings WPA Families,

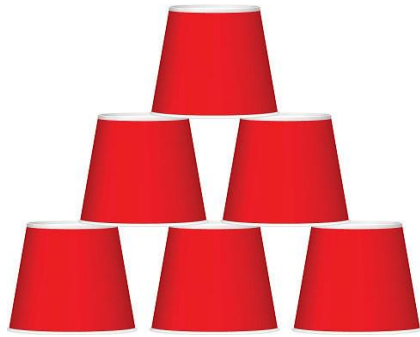
