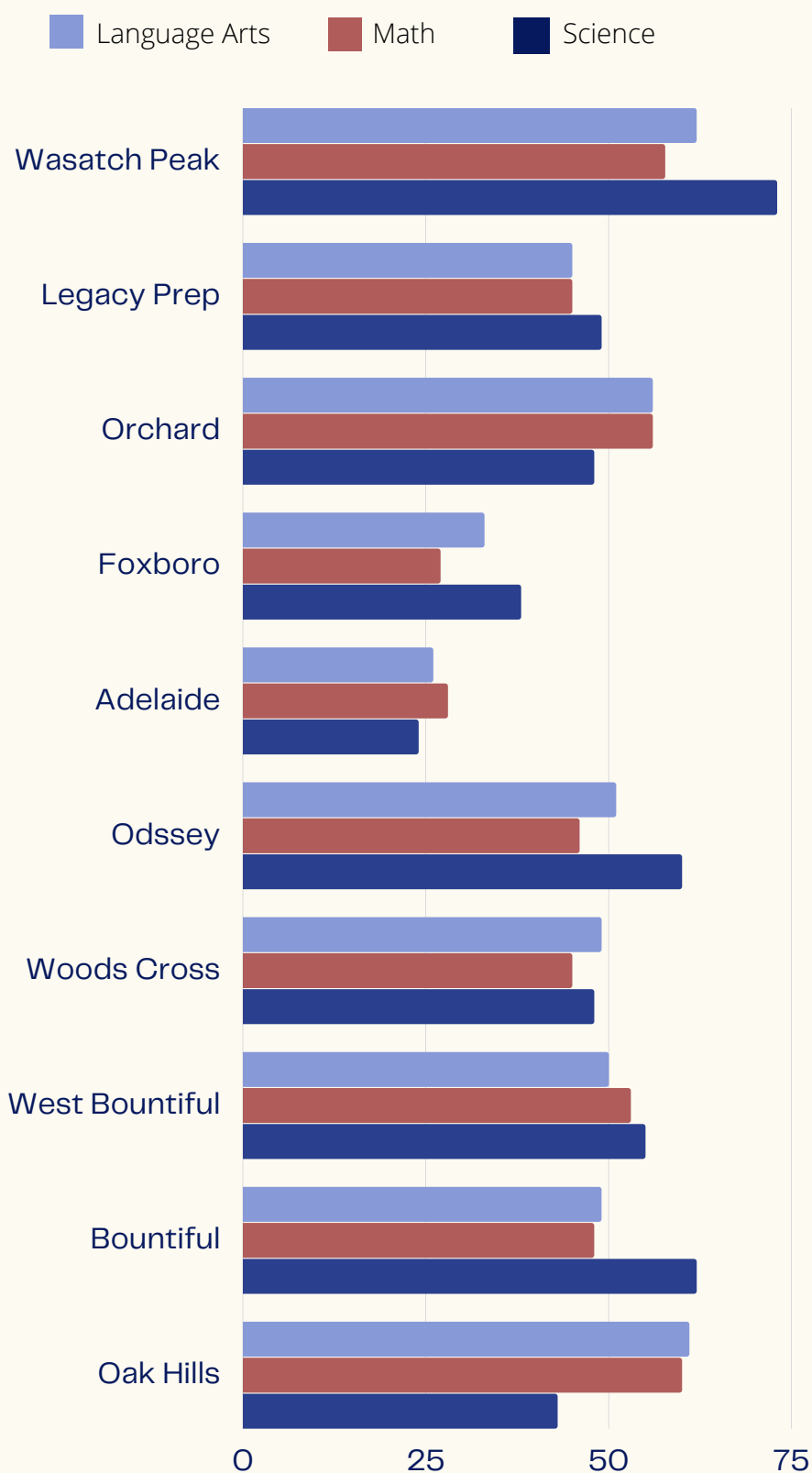


State of the School Summer 2023

Wasatch Peak Academy

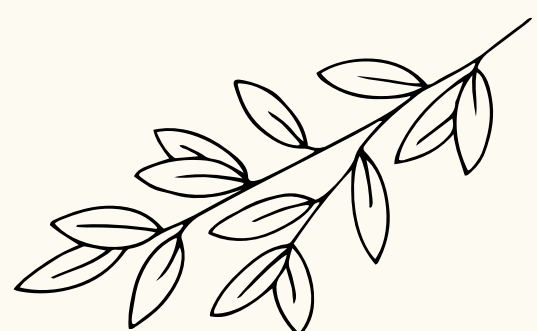

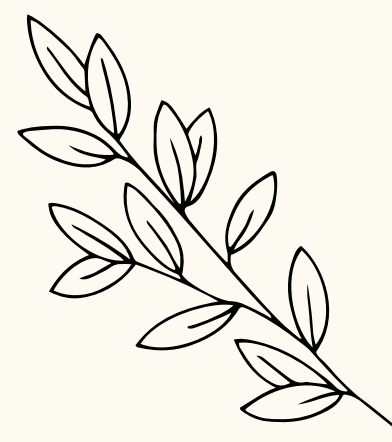


RISE Proficiency 3rd-6th

The RISE assessment is used by the Utah State Office of Education to indicate if students are on grade level in each of the subjects assessed. It is administered in 3rd-6th grades.

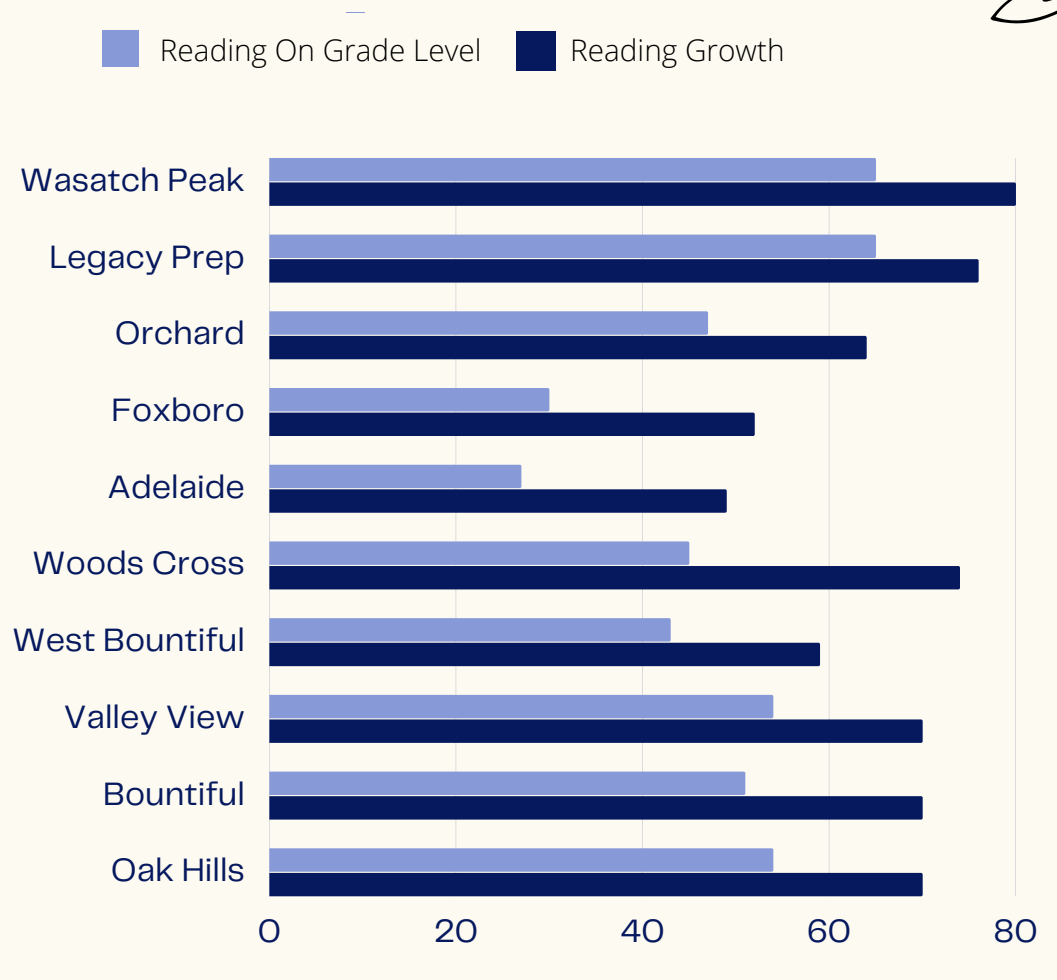
We are thrilled that WPA students saw a schoolwide increase in all three subcategories of the RISE this year. Way to go Patriots!





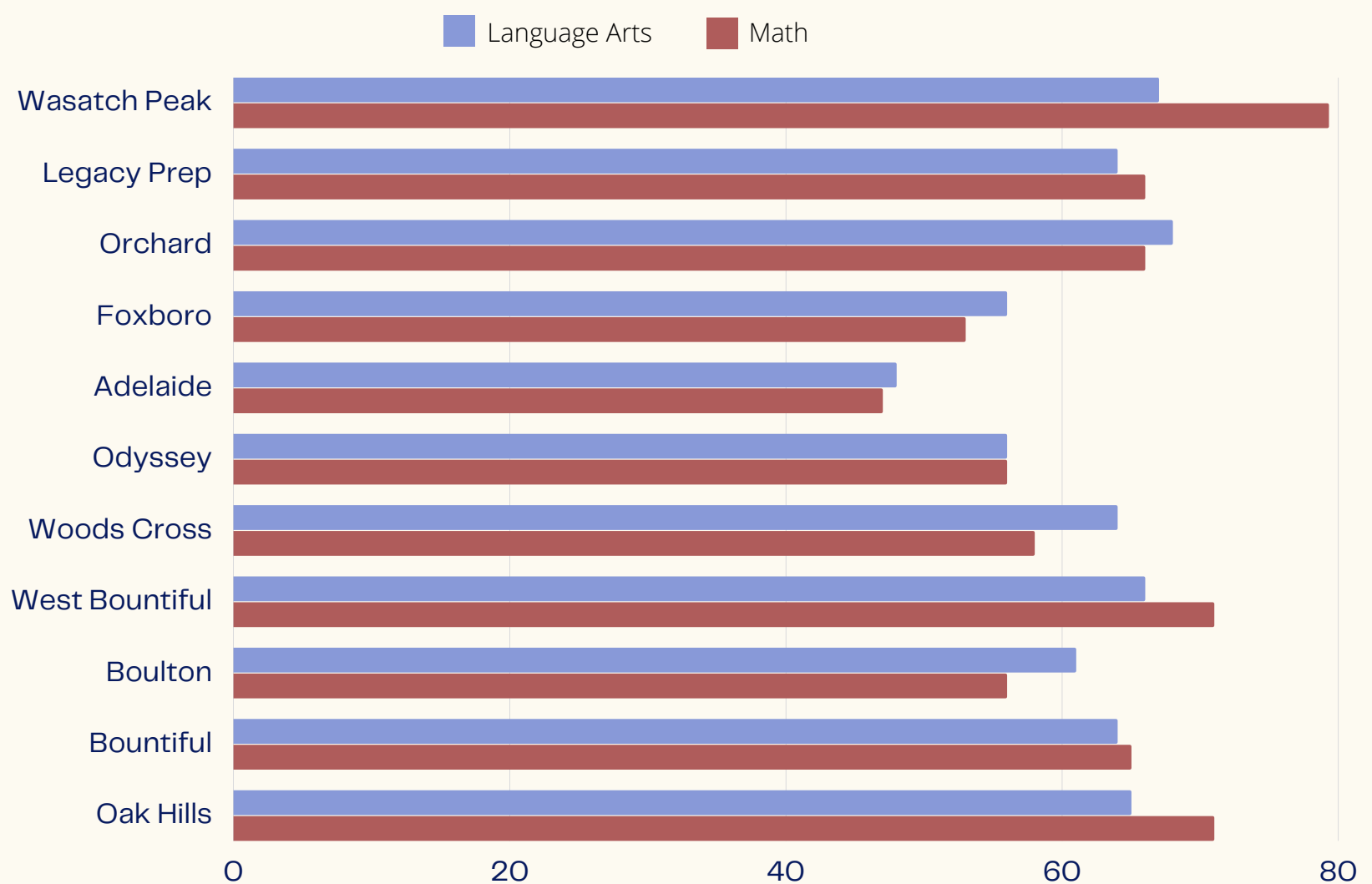
Early Reading Acadience Reading 1st-3rd

Early reading scores focus on 1st-3rd grade students. They focus heavily on phonics and students' ability to decode words smoothly. We were thrilled to see a schoolwide increase in students reading on grade level and are proud of how hard our students and teachers worked.



Student Growth RISE 3rd-6th

Growth Scores are totaled by calculating students' academic improvement over multiple years. While proficiency scores are important, focusing on those scores alone encourages a teach-to-the-middle mentality that leaves high-achieving and struggling students out of the heart of education. We work hard to target growth for EVERY student, which is why we are so proud of the work these rankings represent. NOTE: These scores do not reflect the 2022-2023 school year and are historical data as those scores will not be available to us until the fall. We are very proud of the growth we saw in students this year and are excited to share those numbers with you soon.
